BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

February 24, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township was called to order at 7:00 P.M. The pledge of allegiance to the flag followed. Supervisors present were Chairman Mitch Wolfe and Supervisor Robert Klinger. Also in attendance was Township Secretary Tanya Taatjes.

Minutes – The minutes from the January 27, 2021 BOS meeting were reviewed. Resident Jeff Schatz noted that his suggestion for an estimate to weld the Sterling should state steel and not aluminum or stainless steel. Chairman Wolfe made a motion to approve the change. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Klinger and the motion carried.

Treasurer’s Report – The treasurer’s report was provided for review. It was noted that the Township has not yet received the 2021 Liquid Fuels allocation. Chairman Wolfe made a motion that the treasurer’s report be accepted as submitted subject to audit. Supervisor Klinger seconded the motion. Motion carried.
