

NORTH HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

February 28, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township was called to order at 7:00 P.M. The pledge of allegiance to the flag followed. Supervisors present were Chairman Mitch Wolfe, Supervisor David Pool, and Supervisor Robert Klinger. Also in attendance was Township Secretary Tanya Taatjes.

Minutes – The minutes from the January 24, 2024 BOS meeting were reviewed. Chairman Wolfe made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Supervisor Pool seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Treasurer’s Report – The treasurer’s report was provided for review. Chairman Wolfe made a motion that the treasurer’s report be accepted as submitted subject to audit. Supervisor Klinger seconded the motion. Motion carried. ARP stands for the American Rescue Plan Fund.

- b. A motion was made by Chairman Wolfe to accept the proposal from Schatz Electric to install new LED lighting in the Township building. This includes both the office and shop areas. The proposal is \$3,480.00 and includes removal of the old lighting. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Pool. Motion carried.
