

NORTH HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

October 23, 2024

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township was called to order at 7:00 P.M. The pledge of allegiance to the flag followed. Supervisors present were Chairman Mitch Wolfe and Supervisor Klinger. Also in attendance was Township Secretary Tanya Taatjes.

Minutes – The minutes from the September 25, 2024 BOS meeting were reviewed. Chairman Wolfe made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Supervisor Klinger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Treasurer's Report – The treasurer's report was provided for review. Chairman Wolfe made a motion that the treasurer's report be accepted as submitted subject to audit. Supervisor Klinger seconded the motion. Motion carried. The Township recently bought a new desktop computer due to a bad hard drive.

Public Comments on Agenda Items Only- None

Tax Collectors Report- The monthly Tax Collector Report for September was reviewed by Kloma Kalbach. The third installment for school real estate bills is due 10/31/24. All taxes need to be paid by 12/31/24.

Correspondence-

- a. The Liquid Fuels estimate for 2025 is \$107,648.55. This is about a 2% decrease from last year.

Planning Commission – The PC meeting scheduled for 10/17/24 was canceled.

Road Report- The road crew has been busy cleaning out pipes and getting ready for the winter season. Line painting has been finished. Jeff Schatz would like the Roadmaster to look at the pipe that has settled on Milestone Rd near the Peacock Bridge as well as a tree in the line of sight when turning from Milestone Rd onto Brownsville Rd. The line of sight is on the Township road.

New Business-

- a. A motion was made by Chairman Wolfe and seconded by Supervisor Klinger to allow the Treasurer to set up on line banking with Fulton Bank. Motion carried. The Township would like to open up a separate account for a bridge fund.

- b. Don Lerch has met with all the surrounding Townships for input on the PA 183 Corridor. The main focus is on the Shartlesville Rd and North Heidelberg Rd intersections. Construction is anticipated to begin in 2030.
- c. The 2025 budget was given to the BOS for review.

- a. A motion was made by Chairman Wolfe to donate \$1,220 to the Robesonia Community Library. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Klinger and the motion carried.

Public Comment- Heather Hanna (Candidate for PA State House District 5) was present and will take any questions from residents after the meeting.

A burn ban has not been put into place within the Township. It is anticipated that the County will issue a ban if the dry weather continues.

There has been no update on the JZO revision. Secretary Taatjes will reach out to David Hunter for an update.

Supervisor Klinger wanted to thank Chief Kissling for helping with the pipe work.
