March 26, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township was called to order at 7:00 P.M. The pledge of allegiance to the flag followed. Supervisors present were Chairman Wolfe and Supervisor Klinger. Also in attendance was Township Secretary Tanya Taatjes.

Minutes – The minutes from the February 26, 2025 BOS meeting were reviewed. Chairman Wolfe made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Supervisor Klinger seconded the motion and the motion carried.

They are working to compile a cost estimate for all municipalities to agree upon to move forward with the necessary updates. Marion Township has yet to confirm.

Chief Kissling would like the Township to apply for an LSA (Local Share Account) grant on behalf of the Bernville Fire Company. More information will need to be provided. On April 16, 2025 at 7 P.M. there will be a public presentation for retiring fire marshal Herb Janssen at the Bernville Fire Company.

There was a discussion regarding non registered junk vehicles on residential properties within the Township. The Township will discuss having the Zoning Officer look into it.
