

NORTH HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HEIDELBERG, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE COMPENSATION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 94 of 2024, setting certain parameters for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class, and;

WHEREAS, the act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of no more than 4,999 may be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$3,145.00 annually, and;

WHEREAS, the population of North Heidelberg Township is approximately 1,220, and;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township, Berks County, desires to set compensation on a per-meeting basis.

THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE IS ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, by authority of the same:

Section 1. Each supervisor of North Heidelberg Township entering office after the effective date of this ordinance shall receive compensation as a supervisor in the annual amount not to exceed \$3,145.00.

Section 2. Such compensation shall be paid to supervisors on a per-meeting basis based on the attendance and participation of supervisors at advertised public meeting of the board of supervisors. The per-meeting amount shall be set at \$100.00 and shall be payable monthly. Supervisors may be paid for no more than 31 meetings per year.


Section 3. Such compensation is not payable if a supervisor is absent from a meeting and the absence is not excused. Reasons for excused absences include an emergency or illness of the supervisor or the supervisor's immediate family as well as a family or business travel, death of a family member, or work required by an employer.


Section 4. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of North Heidelberg that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included herein.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2026.
