

NORTH HEIDELBERG TOWNSHIP  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

June 25, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township was called to order at 7:00 P.M. The pledge of allegiance to the flag followed. Supervisors present were Chairman Wolfe, Supervisor Pool, and Supervisor Klinger. Also in attendance was Township Secretary Tanya Taatjes.

Minutes – The minutes from the May 28, 2025 BOS meeting were reviewed. Chairman Wolfe made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Supervisor Pool seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Treasurer’s Report – The treasurer’s report was provided for review. Chairman Wolfe made a motion that the treasurer’s report be accepted as submitted subject to audit. Supervisor Pool seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Correspondence

- a. Free spotted lantern fly traps are available through BCCD. Contact Secretary Taatjes if you would like more information.

Planning Commission

- a. John Hoffert was present to represent the Deeds Minor Subdivision Plan. A waiver request was made that a sketch plan not be required to be submitted prior to the admission of the final plan. A second waiver was requested that monuments and iron pins as shown on the subdivision plan to be established be considered adequate and meet the intent of the Ordinance. Both waivers were accepted by the PC at the 6/19/25 meeting. A motion was also made by the PC to recommend final conditional approval to the BOS subject to the remaining comments in the Kraft Municipal Group review letter dated 6/17/25 regarding perc and probes and the date all waivers are granted by the BOS shall be noted on the plan. A motion was made by Chairman Wolfe and seconded by Supervisor Klinger to accept both waivers. Motion carried. A motion was made by Chairman Wolfe and seconded by Supervisor Pool for final conditional approval of the plan. Motion carried. Perc and probes will be added to the revised final plan once completed.

Kraft Municipal Group – None

Road Report

- a. There is a section of Stricker Rd that will be included in the sealcoat bid for Heidelberg Township. A motion was made by Chairman Wolfe to be included in the bidding and have the work completed by Heidelberg Township. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Klinger and the motion carried. The roadcrew has been busy clearing trees and mowing grass. The base repair work is scheduled for the coming weeks, weather depending.

Old Business

- a. Jeff Schatz is working with RKL on an estimate for propane detectors at the Township building. He recommended one propane detector in the shop mounted above the floor and 2 to 3 carbon monoxide detectors with a delay in the ceiling and one in the meeting room. A wireless system would cost approximately \$10,000. He would like to have two more estimates by the next BOS meeting.

New Business

- a. Bernville Fire Company has been working with Lifeline EMS to put a permanent ALS station at the fire company. The proposal would be for a 10-year contract at a cost of \$7 per household for the first 3 years and \$9 for the remainder of the contract. They would like to meet with the various municipalities that would be served to provide more information.

Solicitor

- a. Solicitor Hartman provided general information regarding temporary signs within the Township. See Secretary Taatjes for more information.

Action Items- None

Public Comment- The Bernville Fire Co and the state police responded to an incident on Heidelberg Farms Lane. There was also a shooting incident at the Township building. The state police were notified and we are currently awaiting a formal report.

Bills- A motion was made by Chairman Wolfe and seconded by Supervisor Klinger to pay bills and adjourn. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:45 P.M.
