BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

November 25, 2025

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of North Heidelberg Township was called to order at 7:00 P.M. The pledge of allegiance to the flag followed. Supervisors present were Supervisor Pool and Supervisor Klinger. Chairman Wolfe was available via phone. Also in attendance was Township Secretary Tanya Taatjes.

Minutes – The minutes from the October 22, 2025 BOS meeting were reviewed. Supervisor Pool made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Supervisor Klinger seconded the motion and the motion carried.
